<b>What is the overall deductible?</b>	For in-network provider \$6,500 individual / \$13,000 family; for <u>out-of-network providers</u> \$13,000 individual / \$26,000 family.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <b><u>providers</u></b> up to the <b><u>deductible</u></b> amount before this <b><u>plan</u></b> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the policy, the overall family <b><u>deductible</u></b> must be met before the <b><u>plan</u></b> begins to pay.
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?</b>	Yes. <u>Preventive care</u> is covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .	This <b><u>plan</u></b> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <b><u>deductible</u></b> amount. But a <b><u>copayment</u></b> or <b><u>coinsurance</u></b> may apply.
